



## Marsha Dianne Jessup

August 17, 1956 - February 3, 2023

Marsha Dianne (Wallace) Jessup, 66, of Kokomo, went home to be with her Lord on the morning of Friday, February 3, 2023 at her home surrounded by her loving family following a courageous battle with cancer.
