Rev. Martin "Marty" T. Hale, age 54, of Richmond, passed away unexpectedly on Friday, February 19, 2016 at Golden Living Center South.

He was born on June 18, 1961 in Hamilton, OH, raised by his grandparents Harold and Ethel Helton.

Marty's testimony, he was brought to Christ through church bus ministry and dedicated the rest of his life to ministry. He earned a degree at Export Bible College in Pennsylvania and began pastoring. He was also a principle and teacher in a Christian School in Virginia. Later moving to Richmond, IN, he continued in Christian education and evangelizing at various youth camps. Marty suffered from a stroke and aneurism early in his life, but his contagious laugh and heart of gold never left him. He will be dearly missed.
