May 11, 1944 - March 6, 2010

Marvin Eugene “Buster” Lundy Jr., 65, of New Castle, died Saturday, March 6, 2010 in Ball Memorial Hospital in Muncie following an extended illness. He was born May 11, 1944 in Richmond, VA, the son of the late Marvin Eugene Lundy Sr. and Dorothy (James) Lundy Welliver.

Buster was a 1962 graduate of New Castle Chrysler High School and attended Ball State University. He retired in 1999 from Delco Remy in Anderson. He loved sports and for many years coached Little League Baseball and Basketball. He found great enjoyment in baseball and could often be found at the ball diamond. In the recent years he loved watching his grandchildren play sports in Indianapolis. He was a big supporter of I.U.
