Marvin M. Matney, 85, of New Castle, passed away peacefully on the evening of Thursday, October 28, 2021 in his home surrounded by his loving family.

He was born on April 1, 1936 in New Castle, Indiana, a son of the late Owen and Myrtle (Gustin) Matney.

Marvin was a graduate of New Lisbon High School where he ran track and played basketball and baseball. He married the love of his life, Phyllis Wright, on July 14, 1957. 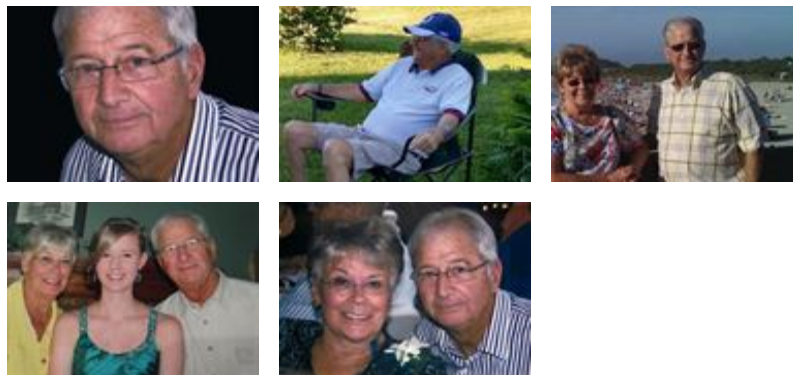
