Mary loved to paint and was very crafty. It was a joy to be around Mary and to watch her just keep going and going. So much so that during the past few years she was nicknamed our "Energizer Bunny". Being deaf, Mary had a unique way of communicating with us and sometimes it was comical.

When Mary would pray she always prayed in sign language and was quite interesting to watch. Mary also went on mission trips with her father and sister. She will be greatly missed by all that knew her. On Sunday night March 19, 2023, our dear sweet aunt entered her eternal home to be with Jesus.
