He was preceded in death by his father, Mark Childress.

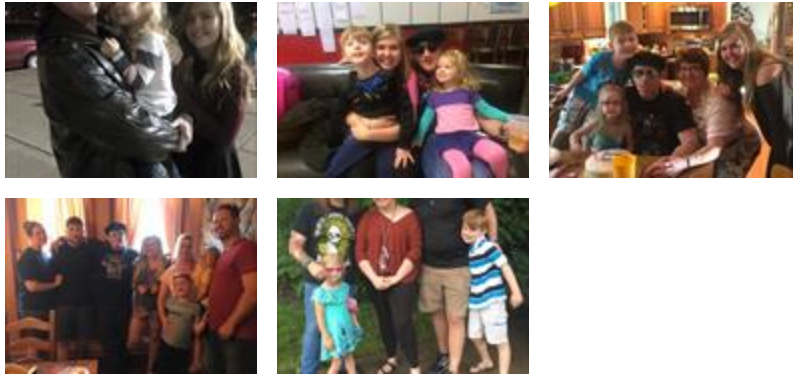
