



## Rev. Merton "Rusty" Rundell III

November 14, 1952 - January 14, 2024

Rev. Merton "Rusty" Rundell III, 71, of Westfield, unexpectedly went home to be with the Lord early Sunday morning, January 14, 2024.

He was born on November 14, 1952, in Chiclayo, Peru, the son of the late Merton Rundell, Jr. and Emma (Mitchell) Rundell.

Rusty met the love of his life and faithful ministry partner, Isabel Fiskeaux, at Hobe Sound Bible College, and they married on June 5, 1976. Shortly following their marriage, they moved to Honduras, where they would serve as missionaries for many years. Throughout life Rusty was always at his best when he was ministering to the Hispanic people.

Rev. Rundell founded the Instituto Teológico Emanuel in San Luis, Santa Bárbara, Honduras, and leaves behind a legacy of 20 years of ministry with Evangelistic Faith Missions in Honduras and over 20 years serving with the Holiness Hispanic Churches in Indiana. In addition to his mission work, he served 25 years in various capacities at Union Bible College in Westfield, preparing young people for ministry. Rev. Rundell retired from UBC in May 2023.

He earned a bachelor's degree in mathematics and business administration from Palm Beach Atlantic University in Florida and an MBA from Indiana

Wesleyan University. He was a long-term ordained minister with the Midwest Pilgrim Holiness Church.

Rusty was a gentle, patient man with a great sense of humor who loved telling jokes. His college minor in engineering would show up often in his love of fixing things. Rusty could repair about anything without getting his white dress shirt dirty. He loved fast cars and was notorious for dropping Chevy 350 engines in his Toyota Land Cruisers. Rusty was a Good Samaritan in Honduras and the US, fixing anything for anyone in need. He also enjoyed being a pilot and a ham radio operator. Rusty loved his family dearly and was a shining example of Jesus to them and many others.

Those left to cherish Rusty's memory include his wife of 47 years, Isabel Rundell; four children, Merton Russell (Cindy) Rundell, IV of Fargo, ND, Sarah Joy (Zechariah) Robberts of Ottawa, KS, Daniel Mark (Sarah) Rundell of Elwood, and Lorna Ruth (Amit) Dutta of Cincinnati, OH; nine grandchildren, Merton Russell "Reece" Rundell V, Larissa, Eleya, and Nathanael Robberts, Quinn, Adelaide, and Gabriel Rundell, and Priya and Ruchi Dutta; two sisters, Mary (Paul) Holmes of Blue Island, IL and Rebecca Veyon of Hobe Sound, FL; a brother-in-law, Steve Veyon of Zanesville, OH; several cousins, nieces and nephews and a host of Hispanic people who consider him their spiritual father and grandfather.

In addition to his parents, Rusty was preceded in death by four grandchildren who died before birth. The family is comforted by knowing he is enjoying his grandchildren that he wasn't able to hold on earth.

Funeral services will be held at 1:00 pm Friday, January 19, 2024, at the Pilgrim Holiness Church, 1413 Westfield Road, Noblesville, IN, with Pastor John Forsee officiating. Burial will follow at Summit Lawn Cemetery in Westfield.

El Reverendo Merton Russell Rundell III, de 71 años, hizo su entrada a la patria celestial para estar con su Señor y Salvador en la madrugada del domingo, 14 de enero, 2024.

Nació el 14 de noviembre, 1952, en Chiclayo, Perú, hijo de Merton Rundell, Jr, y Emma (Mitchell) Rundell. Ambos lo recibieron a paz eterna.

Merton conoció al amor de su vida, y fiel compañera de ministerio, Isabel Fiskeaux, en Hobe Sound Bible College, en Florida. Se casaron el 5 de junio 1976. Poco después de casados, se trasladaron a Honduras, donde sirvieron como misioneros por muchos años. Durante su vida, Merton se sentía más a

gusto cuando estaba ministrando y compartiendo con el pueblo hispano.

Hno. Merton fue el fundador del Instituto Teológico Emanuel en San Luis, Santa Barbara, Honduras, y deja un legado de 20 años de ministerio con Misiones Evangélicas de la Fe, y la Asociación de la Iglesia Emanuel de Honduras. También ministró por más de 20 años en las Iglesias Hispánicas de Santidad en Indiana. Aparte de su labor misionera, sirvió en varias capacidades en Union Bible College en Westfield, IN, ayudando a preparar jóvenes para el ministerio. Hno. Merton se retiró de su trabajo en Union Bible College en mayo del 2023, pero siguió su ministerio entre la comunidad hispana.

Obtuvo un título en matemática y administración de empresas de Palm Beach Atlantic University en Florida, y años después una maestría en administración de empresas de Indiana Wesleyan University. Fue ministro ordenado con la organización Midwest Pilgrim Holiness Church.

Hno. Merton era un hombre paciente y apacible, con un buen sentido de humor. Le gustaba mucho contar chistes y añadía anécdotas en sus mensajes. Sus estudios de ingeniería lo ayudaban a menudo porque le gustaba mucho reparar y arreglar cosas. Podía hacer cualquier trabajo de mecánica sin ensuciar su camisa blanca. Le gustaban los carros veloces, y reemplazaba los motores de sus Toyotas con un motor Chevy 350. Hno. Merton era un buen samaritano, tanto en Honduras como en los Estados Unidos, ayudando y reparando carros y máquinas para quien lo necesitaba. Amaba mucho a su familia y fue un ejemplo fiel de Jesucristo no solo para ellos, sino también para muchos más.

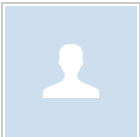

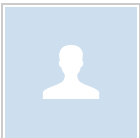
