



Pastor Michael Morgan

August 22, 1948 - November 8, 2021

Pastor Michael Joe Morgan, 73, of Bryant, Indiana, passed away at home on the morning of Monday, November 8, 2021 following a lengthy illness.

He was born on August 22, 1948 in San Fernando, California, a son of the late Arthur Samuel and Helen Jo (Crawley) Morgan.

Mike graduated from Duncan Christian School in Duncan, Oklahoma, and was a 1969 graduate of Bible Missionary Institute in Rock Island, Illinois. He later earned a degree in debate from Black Hawk College, also in Rock Island, Illinois.

In June of 1970, at the age of 21, Mike moved to Connersville, Indiana to become the pastor of the Bible Missionary Church. He would pastor in Connersville for 28 years, and for the past nine years has faithfully served as pastor of Union Chapel in Bryant, Indiana. Mike's first love was ministry, but he was also an entrepreneur, and owned many businesses including H&R Block in Greensburg, Mike Morgan & Associates Real Estate and H&E Machine in Connersville, and was a partner of Kar Mart in Rock Island, Illinois. Mike was a 5-Star Diamond in Free Life International and was currently General Manager of Rite Drive in Muncie.

Mike loved flying his airplane and riding horses and hunting; most of all, Mike

loved being with his family.

Mike was full of energy. He was determined and generous. His greatest passion was loving people, and Mike learned that forgiveness was the greatest gift one could give or receive.

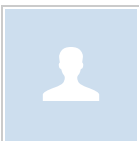
