



Ned E. Klotz II

November 29, 1944 - March 7, 2010

Ned E. Klotz II, 65, of Indianapolis, died Sunday, March 7, 2010 at Wishard Hospital in Indianapolis following a brief illness.

He was born November 29, 1944 in Fort Wayne, Indiana, a son of Betty and Ned E. Klotz.

Ned moved with his family to New Castle in 1957 and was a 1963 graduate of New Castle Chrysler High School. He attended Indiana University for two years and then moved to Crawfordsville where he was employed by R.R. Donnelley for 32 years. The last six years of his career with R.R. Donnelley was spent in their plant in Barbados.

He is survived by his mother, Betty Klotz of New Castle; wife, Janice Klotz of Indianapolis; three children, Stephanie (husband: Mark) Stutsman of Catlin, IL, Ned E. (wife: Kim) Klotz III of Brownsburg and Davon Klotz at home; three grandchildren; two sisters, Cynthia (husband: Mike) Worthington of Dayton, OH and Molly Bryan of Jacksonville, FL; a brother, Todd (wife: Tracy) Klotz of New Castle; and several nieces and nephews.

He was preceded in death by his father, Ned E. Klotz.

A memorial service will be held at 2:00 p.m. Saturday, March 20, 2010 at Holy Trinity Lutheran Church with Pastor Jeff Gramza officiating.

Friends may call from 1:30 p.m. until the time of service Saturday at the church.

Ned donated his body to Indiana University for medical research.
