August 3, 1919 - July 28, 2011

Nina Neal, 91, of New Castle, died Thursday, July 28, 2011 at Henry County Hospital.

She was born August 3, 1919 in Cumberland County, Kentucky, the daughter of the late William and Lavada (Smith) Teel.

Nina and her parents moved to New Castle in 1919, where she grew up and attended New Castle Schools. In 1935 she married Hoy Neal and together they owned and operated Hoy Neal Supply Company for fifty years.

She was a 67 year member of the United Pentecostal Church, where she held many positions; teacher, youth leader, secretary-treasurer, trustee and others. She wrote a book "Keepers of the Flame" on the church's local history. She was an honorary member of Sorosis Literary Club. She was fond of poetry and wrote a number of unpublished poems.

She is survived by a daughter, Elaine (husband: David) Bess of New Castle; a son, David (wife: Nancy) Neal of New Castle; a brother, Fred (wife: Peggy) Teel of Cambridge City; five grandchildren, Dr. Charles A.
