Norma Lea Doyle, 99, of New Castle passed away on the morning of Wednesday, July 31, 2019 at Heritage House Rehabilitation.

She was born on April 10, 1920 in New Castle, a daughter of the late Jesse and Parma (Carpenter) Doyle.
