June 25, 1921 - March 22, 2010

Norman E. Brown, 88, of Applewood Villa in Muncie, and formerly of Mooreland, died Monday, March 22, 2010 at Morrison Woods Health Campus in Muncie.

He was born June 25, 1921 in Mooreland, Indiana, the son of the late Everett and Nellie (Hodson) Brown.

Norman was a 1939 graduate of Mooreland High School. He was a life-long farmer in the Mooreland area. As a hog producer he was a pioneer in the use of the farrowing house and raised feeder pigs. For many years he served on the Blue River Township Advisory Board. He had served as the Blue River Township Trustee and was a member of the Blue River Valley School Board during the time of the consolidation of schools. He was a 30 year member of the First Christian Church in New Castle and had been a member of the Mooreland Lions Club.

He is survived by his wife of 69 ½ years, Marjorie N. (Black) Brown; three daughters, Janet (husband: Michael) Modjeski of Mooreland, Janeane Dobbs of Muncie, and Janelle (husband: Leland) Keesling of Edgewood, New Mexico; six grandchildren, Amy (husband: Robert) Boudrot of Fishers, Angela (husband: Ronnie) Cross of New Castle, Teresa (husband: Jeff) Schwer of Eaton, Eric (wife: Jessica) Dobbs of Muncie, Jason Keesling (wife: Lisa Connell) of Seattle, Washington, and Jamie (husband: Jeff) Hunter of Albuquerque, New Mexico; nine great-grandchildren, Nicholas, Joshua and Blake Boudrot, Jacob, Adria and Ian Cross, Matthew and Mallory Schwer, and
