



## Patricia Evelyn Plemmons

February 4, 1941 - December 16, 2022

Patricia Evelyn Plemmons, age 81, of Tipton, Indiana, died on Friday, December 16, 2022 after a short illness, and was welcomed into Heaven by her husband who preceded her in death on December 9, 2021.


On February 4, 1941, Evelyn was born in Taylor, Michigan, to Alex and Mattie (Taylor) Welch, who preceded her in death. At the age of 15, she met the man of her dreams, Ernest B. Plemmons. Ernest was serving in the US Marine Corps when she fell in love with him and he decided to complete his duty and marry his sweetheart. They were married in Taylor, Michigan, on September 7, 1957. You couldn't go to her house without her giving you something to take home, especially homemade goodies. She would mail baked goods to those who couldn't bake for themselves. Cooking was her all-time favorite.

She moved to Tipton, Indiana, in 2019 to be with family as her husband worked through some memory loss issues. It was a joy for them to live with their daughter, Kathie Manns, and her family during this transition period. While in Indiana, she attended the Noblesville Pilgrim Holiness Church in Noblesville, Indiana.
