



## Pauline N. Phelps

June 20, 1921 - March 8, 2014

Pauline Naoma (Reeves) Phelps, 92, of New Castle, went home to be with the Lord Saturday, March 8, 2014 at The Addison House in New Castle.

She was born June 20, 1921 in Little York, Texas, a daughter of the late Don Lafayette and Naomi Nell (Skaggs) Reeves.

Pauline graduated from Olive Hill Methodist Parochial School in Olive Hill, Kentucky. She married the love of her life Isaac Stanton Phelps on August 21, 1937 and moved to New Castle August 22, 1937. She was employed at Brooks Foods for 32 years, where she was a member of the United Food and Commercial Workers International, Local 700, retiring in January, 1984.

Pauline had been a member of Whittier Lane Baptist Church since 1970 and also a member of Bible Study Fellowship. She was a fabulous seamstress, excellent cook and enjoyed gardening, crocheting and crafts. She also volunteered at Heritage House Rehabilitation for several years.

She is survived by two daughters, Iris Darlene (husband: Jim) Tinkel of Bastrop, Texas and Phyllis Eileen (husband: Rex L.) Carter of New Castle; two sons, Stanton Ray (wife: Kay (South) Phelps of New Castle and Danny Richard Phelps (fiancé: Marilyn Ward Sullivan) of Greensfork; 11 grandchildren; eight great-grandchildren; nine great-great-grandchildren; two sisters, Ella Mae Mendez of Katy, Texas and Alma Fay Cox of Hearne, Texas and several nieces and nephews.
