Philip Delmar Clemens, 84, of New Castle passed away on the evening of Friday, November 19, 2021 at home surrounded by his family.

He was born on September 28, 1937 in Fountain City, Indiana, a son of Presley and Edith (Mitchell) Clemens.

Philip attended and graduated from Fountain City Schools where he played basketball, baseball, football and ran track. After high school, he began working for Wright Patterson Air Force Base as a computer programmer. He was married to the love of his life, Donna Holland on February 21, 1959 in Richmond, Indiana. 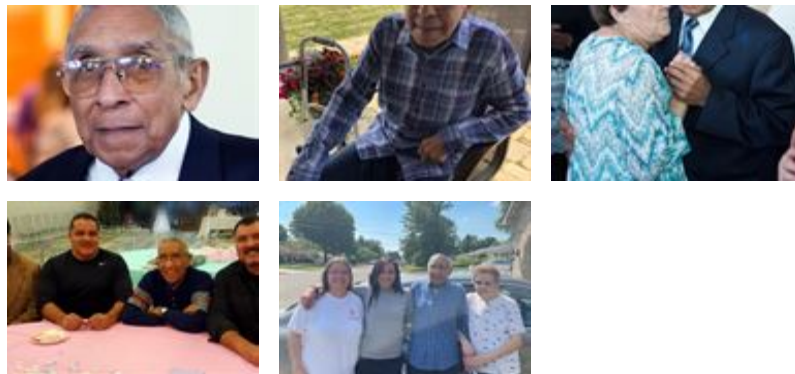
