

Raymond "Bud" Singleton

June 11, 1931 - April 25, 2015

Raymond "Bud" Singleton, 83, of New Castle, went home to be with the Lord on the morning of Saturday, April 25, 2015 at the family residence.

He was born June 11, 1931 in Cincinnati, Ohio, a son of the late Clella and Ella (Robinson) Singleton.

Bud moved to New Castle in 1936 at the age of five. He graduated from New Castle High School with the class of 1949. Bud served his country in the United States Army during the Korean Conflict serving with the 4th Infantry Regimental Combat Team. He was a graduate of the Apprenticeship Program with Naval Avionics. Bud worked as a special technician with the Department of the Navy at the Naval Air Warfare Center in Indianapolis retiring in 1992 after 30 years of service.

Bud was a 74 year member of the First Baptist Church of New Castle.

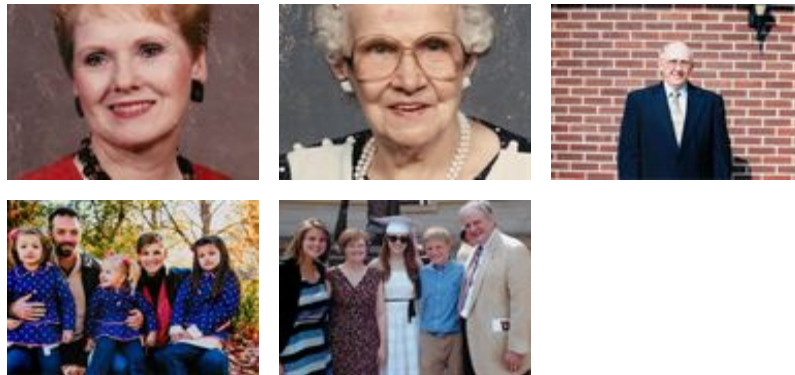
