



Rex Alspaugh

January 7, 1934 - May 25, 2012

Rex Alspaugh, 78, of New Castle, died Friday, May 25, 2012 at IU Health Ball Hospital in Muncie following a brief illness.

Rex was born January 7, 1934 in Henry County, a son of the late Hoyt and Mae (Bowers) Alspaugh.

Rex was a 1952 graduate of Sulphur Springs High School and attended Indiana Central University. He married the love of his life, Wanda (Williams) Alspaugh, on November 22, 1953. He retired from Delco Remy in Anderson following 35 years of employment. He also farmed and was the Superintendent of Henry County Memorial Park for 20 years. Rex was a member of the Elks and Eagles Lodges and Sons of the American Legion. He was also a member of the Sulphur Springs Lodge No. 348 F&AM. Rex was an avid golfer who accomplished seven holes in one.
