Robert Louis Hough, 72, of Losantville, passed away on Thursday, May 7, 2026, at home.

He was born on October 12, 1953, in Beech Grove, Indiana, a son of the late Jerry L. and Jacqueline (Miggenburg) Hough.

Robert was a 1969 graduate of Warren Central High School and proudly served his country as an Intelligence Analyst in the United States Army, serving both at home and abroad. His love for his country remained an important part of who he was throughout his life.

Following his military service, Robert devoted himself to the family business, Hough Brothers Drywall—an innovative company that many years ago helped introduce drywall to the state of Indiana. He took great pride in his work and was known for his determination, strong work ethic, and the quality he brought to every job. For many years, Robert worked for Kurt Hough at H & H Drywall and also owned Robert Hough Drywall before retiring in 2022, leaving behind a legacy that spans generations.
