Robert H. "Bob" Howard, 90, of New Castle, went home to be with the Lord on the evening of Thursday, June 26, 2025, surrounded by his loving family in his home. He had courageously fought cancer for 20 years.

He was born on July 10, 1934, in New Castle, Indiana, a son of the late Alva O. and Letha M. (Bennett) Howard.

Bob grew up in New Lisbon, where he graduated from high school. Throughout his life, Bob had a great love of the community of New Lisbon and his friends there. For 33 years, he worked for the Chrysler Corporation, where he served as a journeyman in machine repair. He retired in 1993.

Bob was a 40-year active member of Grace Baptist Church. He felt that his greatest success was dedicating his life to the Lord in 1987, and the tremendous change that followed in his life. Bob loved serving quietly and unselfishly.
