Rose "Rosie" Marie Fowler, 81, of New Castle, died peacefully Tuesday, May 23, 2017 at her home with her family surrounding her.

Rosie was born March 18, 1936 in Mooreland, IN. Rosie was a 1954 graduate of Union High School. Rosie and Bill Fowler were married on September 26, 1954 and lived in the Cambridge City area and were married for 46 years before Bill passed away in 2001. 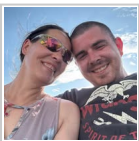

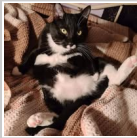

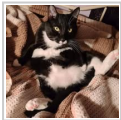
