Sally Jane Ricke, 59, of Cicero, went to be with the Lord Wednesday, March 6, 2013 at her home, following an extended illness.

She was born August 27, 1953 in Shelbyville, a daughter of the late Joseph O. Ricke and Betty Rae (Davis) Ricke.

Sally was a 1971 graduate of Columbus High School in Columbus, Indiana and graduated from Indiana University with a Bachelor of Arts degree in business. She was also a member of the Delta Gamma Sorority at IU.

For the past 20 years Sally was an independent marketing specialist for Ashley Furniture Company and had recently received an award for attaining 20 million dollars in annual sales. She also was a former owner of a Baskin-Robbins franchise on Michigan Road in Indianapolis.

Sally loved people and they loved her in return. She loved to laugh and was always smiling. She especially loved the time she spent with her family and friends, spending time on the water and traveling. Sally could often be found riding her golf cart around Cicero with her Dachshunds, Tarzan and Jane.
