January 30, 1943 - February 24, 2011

Tony E. Kinnett, 68, of rural Middletown, went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, February 24, 2011 at the Golden Living Center in Muncie.

He was born January 30, 1943 in New Castle, the son of the late Lovell and Geneva (Staton) Kinnett.

Tony was a 1961 graduate of Sulphur Springs High School and a graduate of the United Electronics Laboratories, Louisville, Kentucky. He received his Associate Degree in Electronic Engineering Technology from Cleveland Institute in 1986. He retired from ABB in Muncie in June, 1998, after 36 years of combined service with ABB and Westinghouse Electric Corporation. He served in the Vietnam War with the U.S. Army and was awarded the Purple Heart twice, the National Defense Service Medal, Vietnam Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, Overseas Service Bar, Combat Infantryman Badge, Marksman Badge and Expert Badge. He was a member of Grace Baptist Church.

He is survived by his wife, Mary (Gibson) Kinnett, whom he married August 9, 1963; a daughter, Susan (husband: Greg) Albertson of Attica, IN; a son, Michael Kinnett of Middletown; five grandchildren, Olivia, Tyler and Hunter Albertson of Attica, IN, Tony Kinnett of Middletown and Emily Kinnett of Ellettsville, IN; a sister, Mary Jane (husband: Ron) Walcott of Middletown; a niece, Catherine (husband: Jeff) Yergin of Middletown; a nephew, Rich (wife: Melinda) McGee of Indianapolis; a sister-in-law, Lois (husband: Conrad) Maasdorp of Clarksville, IN; and a brother-in-law, Gary (wife: Kathy) Gibson of
