



Rev. Vernon Eugene Stimpert

July 7, 1930 - April 23, 2013

Rev. Vernon Eugene Stimpert, 82, of New Castle, went home to be with the Lord on Tuesday, April 23, 2013 at his home.

He was born July 7, 1930, in Lewisville, OH, a son of the late Clarence and Blanche (Denbow) Stimpert. He was a member of the South Side Church of the Nazarene.

Rev. Stimpert was a full time pastor, the following encompasses his pastoral career; August, 1957, Kingston Church of the Nazarene, Kingston, OH; February, 1961, Lithopolis Church of the Nazarene, Lithopolis, OH; August, 1965, Southpoint Church of the Nazarene, Southpoint, OH; February, 1967, Northland Church of the Nazarene, Columbus, OH; February, 1978, Warren Avenue Church of the Nazarene, Columbus, OH, there he founded the first Cambodian Church of the Nazarene; February, 1987, Johnstown Church of the Nazarene, Johnstown, OH; October, 1987, Zanesville North Side Church of the Nazarene, Zanesville, OH; He retired from the ministry in July, 1995 and was hired as full- time Chaplain and Hospice Care at Good Samaritan Hospital, Zanesville, OH until 2000.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 53 years, Norma Lee (Billman) Stimpert, 69, of Lewisville, OH, in September, 2002; He then met, married and is now survived by his wife, Juaneta Elaine Stimpert of New Castle.
