



## Virginia Hyatt

January 12, 1944 - December 8, 2016

Virginia Charlene (Kratz) Hyatt, 72, of Cincinnati, went home to be with the Lord on the morning of Thursday, December 8, 2016 following a lengthy illness.

She was born January 12, 1944 in Indianapolis, Indiana, a daughter of the late Arthur Alvin and Dorothy Francis (Wise) Kratz.

Virginia was a 1962 graduate of Harry E. Wood High School in Indianapolis, IN. She attended God's Bible School and College in Cincinnati, Ohio. On November 16, 1963, Virginia married the love of her life, Floyd E. Hyatt, Jr. She was a homemaker and enjoyed sewing and crafts. Virginia was an excellent baker winning many state fair blue ribbons. She was a long-time member of the Lima Pilgrim Holiness Church and ministered alongside her husband for 30+ years every week in the Hamilton County Justice Center. For many years she operated the phone desk at God's Bible School and College.

*It was a real privilege to help care for Virginia the few times I was able. She always seemed to make me smile with her cute sense of humor. Our family will greatly miss her.*

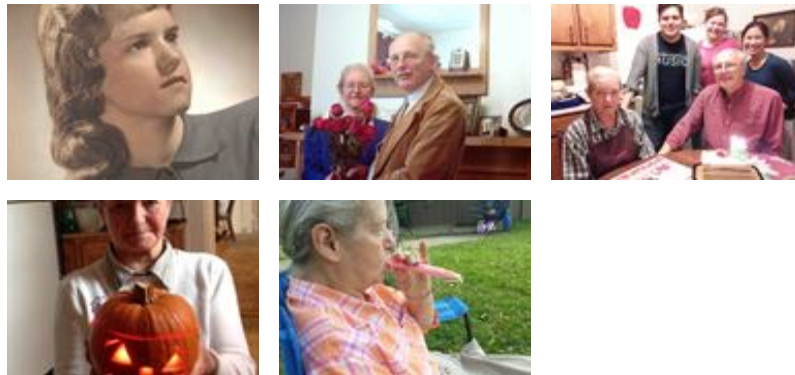
